Due to the industrial action scheduled during the exhibitions INTERMAT Paris and WOC Europe, our teams are fully mobilised to help you and offer you a few tips for your travel and transport plans.

Coming by car?

In view of the planned strike action, transport by private car remains the best option to travel to the show.

The following link will allow you to consult the real time [traffic conditions to get to Paris-Nord Villepinte Exhibition Centre](#).

Car parks are at your disposal inside the Exhibition Centre perimeter.

Coming by plane?

Where possible, you should try to fly to Paris-CDG airport.

From there, you have several options to get to the Exhibition Centre:

- **FREE SHUTTLES from Monday 23 to Saturday 28 April**

Shuttle buses will be operated between Paris-CDG airport and the Paris-Nord Exhibition centre from 8.30am to 12.30pm and from 2.30 to 6.30pm.

PARIS-CDG > PARIS NORD VILLEPINTE

Stops are located at:

Terminal 1 Gate 8 – Departures level

Terminal 2D Gate 9 – Arrivals level

Terminal 2F – Walkway between 2F and 2E – Arrivals level

PARIS NORD VILLEPINTE > PARIS-CDG

Stop located at: Esplanade (in front of Hall 1)

- **CARPPOOLING:** a range of community platforms exist connecting up travellers. Choose the one that's right for you (see detailed offers in the Carpooling paragraph)

Note

During major periods of disruption, (strikes, adverse weather, etc.) Air France and other major airlines often issue "commercial measures" for tickets that initially could not be changed or refunded, meaning that tickets may be modified without charge subject to certain conditions.

Coming by train?

- **International lines**

Eurostar and **Thalys** services are expected to run according to schedule on 23 and 24 April.

- **Lines in France**

The French railway company **SNCF** has decided to suspend seat bookings for the strike days scheduled in April, notably the 13,14, 18,19, 23/24 and 28/29 April.

If you have already booked a ticket on the French railways for a date on which a strike is scheduled, **please be informed that SNCF will only confirm definite services on the day before the service.**

FROM GARE DU NORD and PORTE MAILLOT, 23/04 & 24/04

Gare du Nord <-> INTERMAT

Pick up:

- Gare du Nord: 112 rue Maubeuge, 75010 Paris, (Bus parking, point of SNCF baggage service)
- INTERMAT : in the Hall 8

Shuttle schedules:

From 8.00 am to 11.30 am: every 15 minutes from Gare du Nord to d'INTERMAT

From 4.30 pm to 7.00 pm: every 15 minutes from INTERMAT to Gare du Nord

Porte Maillot <-> INTERMAT

Pick up:

- Porte Maillot : Pershing Autocars Parking (Boulevard Pershing, Bus departure to Beauvais)
- INTERMAT: in the Hall 8

Shuttle schedules:

From 8.00 am to 11.30 am: every 15 minutes from Porte Maillot to INTERMAT

From 4.30 pm to 7.00 pm: every 15 minutes from INTERMAT to Porte Maillot
